

## **RELIGIOUS EDUCATION INFORMATION FOR YOUTH**

### **AT IMMACULATE CONCEPTION**

- Religious Education classes are available for children in Kindergarten through 6<sup>th</sup> grade. Classes are every other week, either Sundays, 8:00 a.m. – 9:45 a.m. or Wednesdays, 4:15 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. Classes begin in September and go through April. Be sure to pick up a Religious Education calendar for class dates.
- Complete one Family Information form per family.
- Complete one Student Information form per student. Please read both sides, and complete the form.
- Sacramental Preparation is in conjunction with Religious Education classes.

- In order for your child to attend Religious Education classes or Sacramental Preparation classes, your family must be registered members of the parish.

- Our programs are financially supported through the weekly offertory of our parishioners. If you are not already contributing, please prayerfully consider donating on a regular basis, either using envelopes or direct deposit. - Teachers are ALWAYS needed for RE. We look to our parents to volunteer to serve in this ministry. If we do not have enough volunteer teachers, we may be unable to provide certain sections. Contact Kathleen Donohoe, DRE in the parish office if you would like more information on teaching. Creative teaching options are available (i.e. job sharing, class assistant, co-teaching).
- Registration for Religious Education is from July 1<sup>th</sup> – August 31<sup>st</sup>. Classes begin the week of September 26<sup>th</sup>. Forms are due no later than September 1<sup>st</sup>.
- For children in 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade, Jr. High Youth Group will be held on Sunday evenings, after 5:00 p.m. Mass. See bulletin for more information or contact Mark Evevard, Youth Minister.
