FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

That poor woman. How terrifying to be dragged in front of all those righteous men, so thrilled to finally have an actual, breathing sinner in front of them, and stones to boot! But I've always thought this event was a set-up. Yes, they may have known that a woman was consorting with a man not her husband. But perhaps this situation provided the perfect trap for Jesus, the Jew who preached compassion when faced with the rigors of the Law.

It must have been soul-deadening to walk around under the weight of those 619 laws.

I imagine those scribes and Pharisees had to have found the Law onerous as well. Had they noticed Jesus during the Festival, and assumed he'd be back in the Temple area the next day? Did they take advantage of the situation with the woman, and use her to force a confrontation with Jesus about compassion? The truth is, there isn't a single known event of Jews stoning a woman caught in adultery.

I wonder if that proscription, coming all the way back in Leviticus 20:10, was something that bothered the Jews. Were they hoping Jesus would give them a way out of a terrible death penalty they would never have exacted anyway?

He did give them a way out, twice. The first was when he suggested that the one who was without sin throw the first stone. Whew! We're all saved! We don't have to pretend that we were actually going to kill her.

The second time Jesus offered a way out, of course, was on the Cross. That's our way out from revenge, and violence. We should go, then, and not sin anymore.

How does your compassion offer a way out to people in your life?

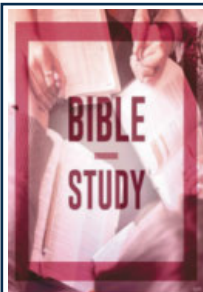

QUINTO DOMINGO DE CUARESMA

Esa pobre mujer. ¡Qué aterrador sería ser arrastrada frente a todos esos hombres justos, que estaban tan entusiasmados de tener finalmente frente a ellos a un pecador real, de carne y hueso, y piedras al alcance para lanzarle! Pero siempre he pensado que este evento fue una trampa. Sí, es posible que se hayan enterado de que una mujer se asociaba con un hombre que no era su marido. Pero tal vez esta situación proporcionó la trampa perfecta para Jesús, el judío que predicaba la compasión ante los rigores de la Ley.

Debe haber sido agotador caminar bajo el peso de esas 619 leyes.

Me imagino que aquellos escribas y fariseos también sabían del peso implacable de la ley. ¿Habían visto a Jesús durante el Festival y asumieron que regresaría al área del Templo al día siguiente? ¿Se aprovecharon de la situación de la mujer y la usaron para forzar una confrontación con Jesús sobre la compasión? La verdad es que no se conoce ningún caso en el que judíos hayan apedreado a una mujer sorprendida en adulterio.

Me pregunto si esa imposición, que se remonta a Levítico 20:10, era algo que no les gustaba a los judíos, que no querían hacer. ¿Esperaban que Jesús les diera una salida a una terrible pena de muerte que de todos modos nunca hubiesen impuesto?

Les dio una salida, dos veces. La primera fue cuando sugirió que el que estuviera sin pecado tirara la primera piedra. ¡Uf! ¡Estamos todos salvos! No tenemos que fingir que realmente íbamos a matarla. La segunda vez que Jesús ofreció una salida, por supuesto, fue en la Cruz. Ésa es nuestra salida a la venganza y a la violencia. Por lo tanto, deberíamos irnos y no pecar más.
