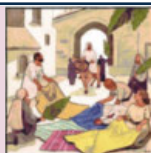

Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion

The entire Passion account moves so quickly. It begins with a peaceful Passover meal, then moves to the Garden, where, after his Agony, the soldiers come with swords and torches. He asks why they put on such a big show when they could have arrested him at any time during the day. But, he says, "This is your hour, the time for the power of darkness."

There are times when the power of darkness seems to take hold of previously good and reasonable people. Nazi Germany comes to mind. Looking at videos of those ghastly rallies, with thousands giving the Nazi salute, it's impossible to imagine that darkness could take hold so quickly, but in less than six months the concentration camps were turned into extermination camps.

When we visited Yam Vashem, the museum in Jerusalem that remembers the Holocaust, our guides wondered that Germany could have been the locus of the viciousness against the Jews. It had, just before Hitler took power, been the image of democratic discourse.

Perhaps the most compelling moment of Luke's account, though, remembers that there were two thieves crucified on either side of Jesus. One was belligerent until the end, while the other was profoundly moved by his encounter with Jesus.

I want to be the thief who is deeply touched and converted by Jesus. I want to release all my defensiveness and arrogance. I want all my sinfulness to melt at the feet of Jesus. I want to say, "I am guilty, after all. Please heal me, Jesus."

Are you ready to release all your unhealed wounds unto the foot of the Cross? Jesus, remember us when you come into your kingdom.

What bitterness are you willing to release this Palm Sunday?

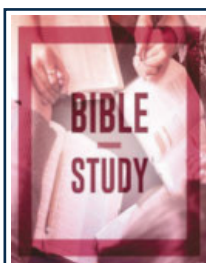

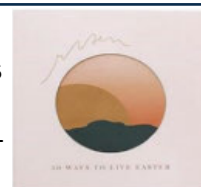

Domingo de Ramos

Todo el recuento de la Pasión avanza muy rápidamente. Comienza con una pacífica cena de Pascua, luego se traslada al Huerto, donde, después de su terrible agonía, los soldados llegan con espadas y antorchas. Pregunta por qué montaron un espectáculo tan grande cuando pudieron haberlo arrestado en cualquier momento del día. Pero les dice: "Esta es vuestra hora, el tiempo del poder de las tinieblas".

Hay momentos en que el poder de las tinieblas parece apoderarse de personas que antes eran buenas y razonables. Me viene a la mente la Alemania nazi. Al mirar videos de esas espantosas manifestaciones, con miles de personas haciendo el saludo nazi, es imposible imaginar que la oscuridad pudiera apoderarse tan rápidamente, pero en menos de seis meses los campos de concentración se convirtieron en campos de exterminio.

Cuando visitamos Yam Vashem, el museo de Jerusalén que recuerda el Holocausto, nuestros guías se preguntaron cómo Alemania llegó a ser el epicentro de la crueldad contra los judíos. Justo antes de que Hitler tomara el poder, había sido la imagen del discurso democrático.

Sin embargo, quizás el momento más convincente del relato de Lucas sea recordar que había dos ladrones crucificados a cada lado de Jesús. Uno fue agresivo hasta el final, mientras que el otro quedó profundamente conmovido por su encuentro con Jesús.

Quiero ser el ladrón profundamente conmovido y convertido por Jesús. Quiero deshacerme de toda mi actitud defensiva y mi arrogancia. Quiero que toda mi pecaminosidad se derrita a los pies de Jesús. Quiero decir: "Después de todo, soy culpable. Por favor, sáname, Jesús".

¿Estás listo para dejar todas tus heridas no curadas al pie de la Cruz? Jesús, acuérdate de nosotros cuando llegues a tu reino.

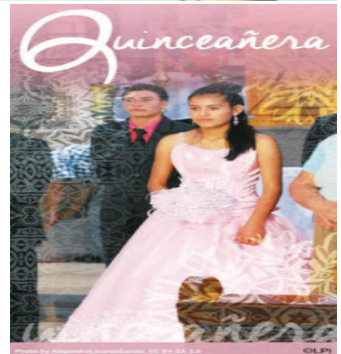

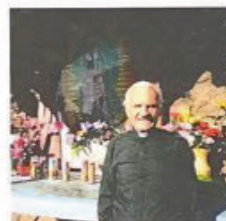

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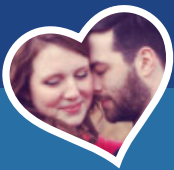
