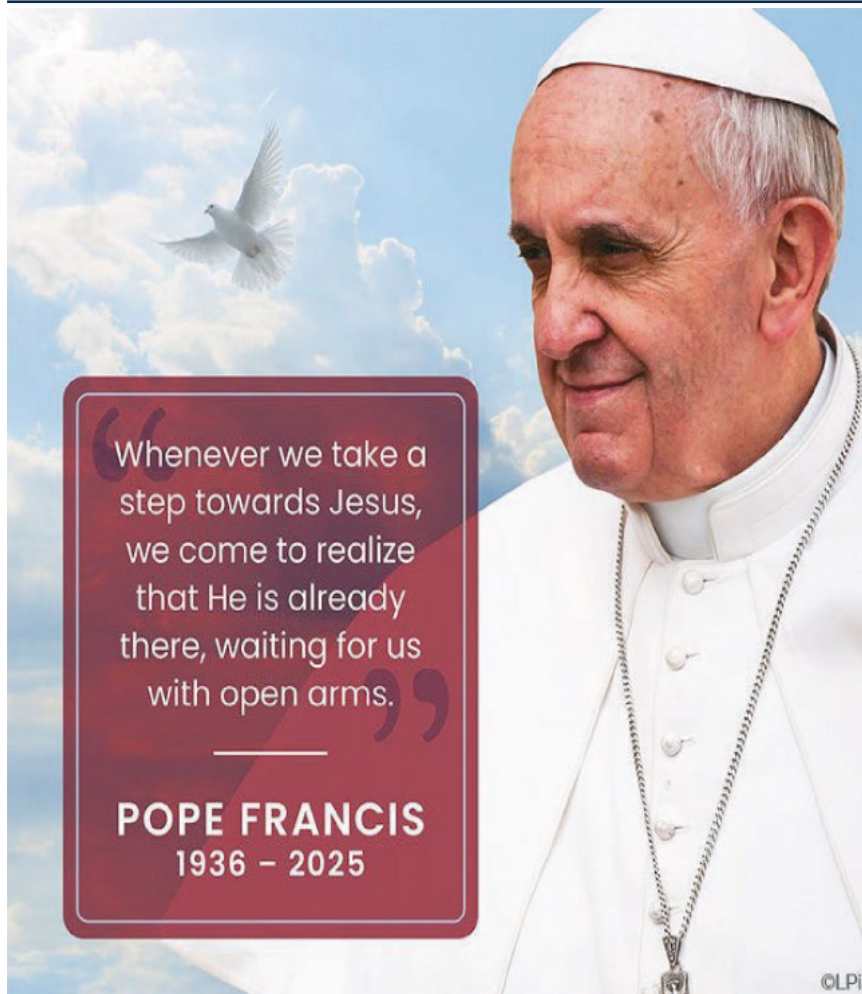

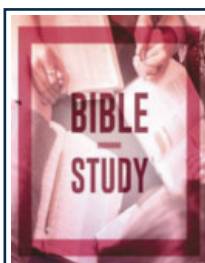

Domingo de la Divina Misericordia

Si ves el programa Dateline muy seguido, no querrás volver a contestar el teléfono ni el correo electrónico. Nos aseguran que los depredadores están por todas partes, y que nunca seremos más inteligentes que ellos. Es mejor sospechar de todos.

Me pregunto si Tomás oyó decir que Jesús estaba vivo, y su corazón hecho pedazos ya no podía sufrir más decepciones. Era mejor endurecer su corazón. Los fanáticos religiosos estaban en todas partes. Nadie iba a dejarlo en ridículo.

Y ahora sus propios hermanos, los que habían presenciado cuando Jesús resucitó a Lázaro, ¡lo recibieron en la puerta, gritando extasiados porque habían visto al Señor.

Pero Tomás no se dejó engañar. No. "Si no veo las marcas de los clavos en sus manos, y meto mi dedo en el hueco de los clavos, y meto mi mano en su costado, no creeré."

Casi puedes oír su tono de voz. Está luchando por contener las lágrimas. Él quiere creer con todo su ser. Pero él sabe lo que los romanos le hicieron a Jesús. Él no puede estar vivo. ¿O sí puede?

¡Y luego, el siguiente domingo por la noche, Jesús se les apareció nuevamente! Se dirigió directamente hacia el estupefacto (¡y rebosante de alegría!) Tomás. ¿Te imaginas si Jesús tomara tus dedos y los colocara sobre sus heridas, y pusiera tus manos en su costado? Caerías de rodillas, como Tomás, y gritarías: "¡Señor mío y Dios mío!"

Después de la experiencia que le cambió la vida con el Resucitado, Tomás se propuso contarle al mundo lo que había visto. Viajó por todo el Medio Oriente y Asia, y finalmente murió en la India, donde es venerado entre los cristianos indios como el santo patrón de la India.

El predicó la Divina Misericordia de Jesús.

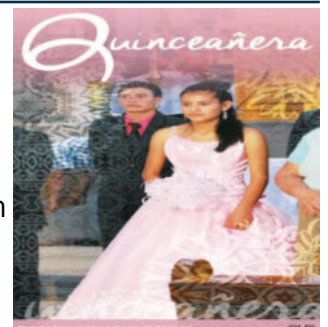

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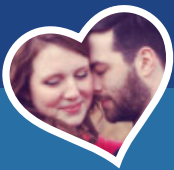

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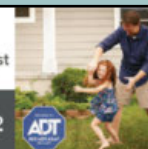


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
