Third Sunday of Easter

I heard the Passion this year more than any other Lent. Or, maybe I just HEARD the Passion more—really heard it, really contemplated it, was really broken over it, more than ever before. In the same way, I resolve to read the Easter gospels with brand-new eyes this season as well.

And so, I have some questions. When Jesus visited his disciples at the Sea of Tiberias, we don't know how much time had elapsed since he appeared to them (with Thomas) one week after Easter. We know that they'd returned to their occupation before being called to follow Christ. What were they thinking on that boat that day? Did we dream all of this? And yet, we all remember the Risen Jesus appearing to us in the room where we were hiding, and, the second time, Thomas even felt his wounds!

So, what did they think had happened to Jesus since he appeared to them? Weren't they beside themselves, not knowing where he was, or what his resurrection meant for their futures? (I suspect Peter was PARTICULARLY interested in that question.) Apparently, they had reunited with their families in the Galilee, after traveling with Jesus for three years. They were back fishing, making a living.

The story has a familiar pattern, maybe in our own lives, too. A long night on frightening waters. Hunger. Uncertainty. Fear. And then, a familiar Voice, encouraging them to try another way.

Hear the voice of Pope Francis, calling us from heaven: Try another way.

My question, then, as I read this gospel: what new way is God showing me? Do I have the faith to cast my net to the other side?

What behaviors have not been fruitful for you? How will you try another way?

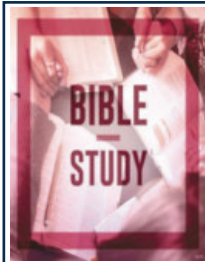

loving and caring...

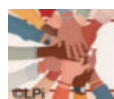
A blessing to my needles - to be holders of my stitch-

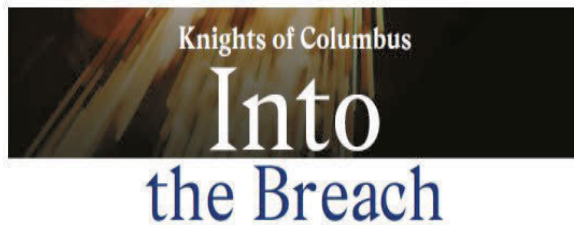

Tercer Domingo De Pascua

Escuché la Pasión este año más que cualquier otra Cuaresma. O, tal vez ESCUCHE la Pasión más—realmente la escuché, realmente la contemple, realmente me dejé quebrantar por ella, mucho más que antes. De la misma manera, me propongo leer los evangelios de Pascua con ojos nuevos también en esta temporada.

Entonces, tengo algunas preguntas. Cuando Jesús visitó a sus discípulos en el Mar de Galilea, no sabemos cuánto tiempo había transcurrido desde que se les apareció (con Tomás) una semana después de Pascua. Sabemos que habían regresado a la ocupación que tenían antes de ser llamados a seguir a Cristo. ¿Qué estaban pensando en ese barco ese día? ¿Fue todo un sueño? Y, sin embargo, todos recordamos

cuando Jesús Resucitado apareció ante nosotros en la habitación donde estábamos escondidos y, la segunda vez, ¡Tomás incluso tocó sus heridas!

Entonces, ¿qué creían que le había sucedido a Jesús desde que se les apareció? ¿No estaban desesperados, sin saber dónde estaba ni qué significaba su resurrección para su futuro? (Sospecho que Pedro estaba PARTICULARMENTE interesado en esa pregunta.) Aparentemente, se habían reunido con sus familias en Galilea, después de viajar con Jesús durante tres años. Estaban pescando de nuevo y ganándose la vida.

La historia tiene un patrón familiar, tal vez también en nuestras propias vidas. Una larga noche en aguas aterradoras. Hambre. Incertidumbre. Miedo. Y entonces, una voz familiar, animándolos a probar otro camino.

Escucha la voz del Papa Francisco, llamándonos desde el cielo: Prueben otro camino.

Entonces, al leer este evangelio, mi pregunta es la siguiente: ¿Qué nuevo camino me está mostrando Dios? ¿Tengo la fe de echar mis redes por el otro lado?

¿Qué comportamientos no han sido fructíferos para ti? ¿Cómo vas a tratar otro camino?

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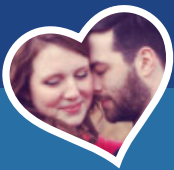
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
