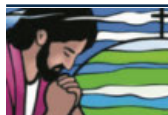

Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord

Okay, Church. It's that time of year again. This is the week when the entire Church does a full-court novena. We celebrate Ascension Thursday today, on a Sunday, because it often goes unnoticed on the weekday, and it's a tremendous solemnity. So, yes, technically, the novena started last Thursday. Still, all 14 million practicing Catholics worldwide observe Ascension today, which means we collectively begin our joyful wait for the coming of the Spirit in one week.

We do this in solidarity with those disciples—Mary, the mother of Jesus, being foremost among them (Acts 1:12)—who followed Jesus' instruction not to leave Jerusalem until they received the Spirit (Lk. 24:48). Nine days later, a noise like a driving wind filled the house where they were staying, and the Holy Spirit descended.

So YES! We keep this Pentecost novena (seven days, really) as a worldwide Church, and we wait in joyful hope for the Spirit to come to us in mighty ways next Sunday on the great feast of the Holy Spirit, the birthday of the Church.

I entreat us all to storm heaven during this particularly potent week of prayer. I'm begging for an immediate ceasefire in Gaza, and for immediate food and medicine to be rushed to the millions of people who will die of famine without humanitarian aid.

Once again this year, I invite each of us to imagine someone in the world of our same gender, age, and name who needs our prayers this year. There are at least thirteen different global spellings of Kathleen. Google your name and randomly choose someone. They can thank you when they meet you in heaven.

What will be your novena prayer this year?

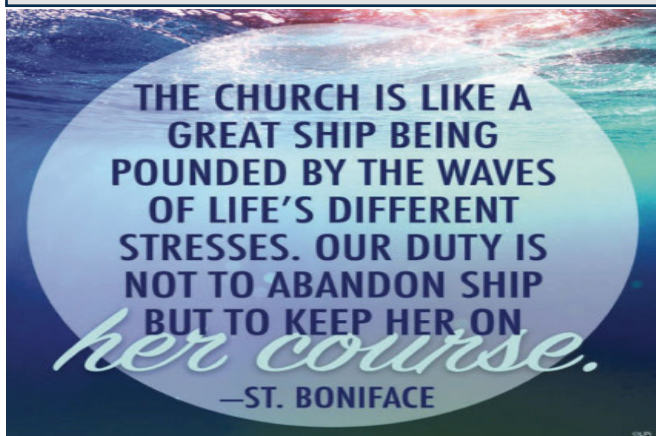

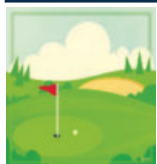

Dear Parishioners of Immaculate Conception,

As disciples of Christ, our lives are richly blessed when we prioritize giving thanks to God for His many blessings. We appreciate your support at Immaculate Conception, which allows us to continue proclaiming the Gospel and sharing the love of God.

I am honored to present the Annual Financial Statement of the Parish for fiscal year 2024. As the pastor of Immaculate Conception Parish, I am continually humbled by the goodness and generosity of our parish family. We are blessed to have many generous members who help make the burden lighter for everyone.

We have 2370 registered families at Immaculate Conception, 132 new families in the past year. Our Sacramental life continues to thrive. In 2024 there were 111 baptisms, 81 First Communions, 113 Confirmations, 22 Marriages and 32 Funerals.

Your gifts enable the ministerial work that we do at Immaculate Conception and beyond. We were able to offer the Rescue Project to our parish and continuing education through the Ephesians 4 program. We felt the strains of the growth in our community and had to find new ways to use our space like revamping our lower-level classroom space. We also had some major repairs in replacing one of the parish heat pumps and updating our fire panel, kitchen oven and security system.

Your donations allowed us to support many charitable foundations and those in need. Along with 10% of our weekly offertory to each of the Archdiocese of Denver's special collections we gave to the following programs:

Catholic outreach, religious orders, living assistance, protection of human life, building projects within Archdiocese of Denver, Catholic Education (of all ages) and young adult groups.

Due to your continuous generosity, our offertory has steadily increased each year for the past 15 years (excluding the covid years). In the first half of fiscal year 2025, however, we are experiencing a slight decrease in our revenues. This is occurring while the activities and costs of the parish continue to grow. I want to assure you that we are financially stable as a parish, however, given our growing community and expenses I would like to ask you to prayerfully consider beginning or increasing your weekly offertory to help our parish meet its general operations goals this year.

Our faith grows as we express our gratitude to the Lord for all the blessings He has given us. Thank you for generously sharing your treasure with us.

Los invito a todos a bombardear el cielo durante esta semana con potentes oraciones. Ruego por un cese al fuego inmediato en Gaza y que se envíen urgentemente alimentos y medicinas a los millones de personas que morirán de hambre sin ayuda humanitaria.

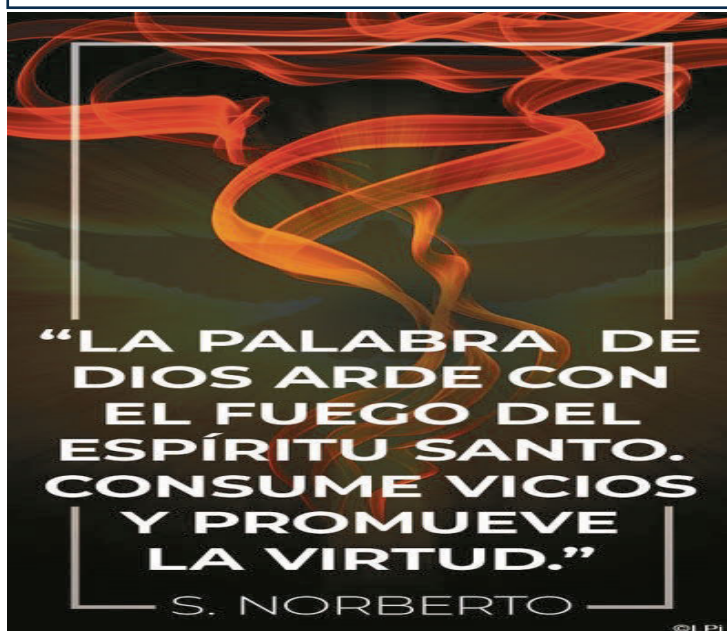

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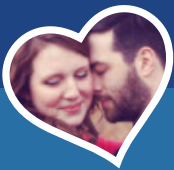

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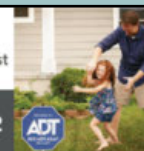


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
