### Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

"For this command that I enjoin on you today is not too mysterious and remote for you."

Whenever I read that beautiful passage from Deuteronomy 30, I remember my friend Becky, who wandered into the parish where I worked many years ago and immediately fell in love with the whole "Catholic Thing."

She'd never been in a Catholic Church. She stared at the statues of the saints. When the Bread and Cup were elevated, she could scarcely breathe.

She became the most devout student. She could sit with the missalette for hours, asking questions about why we do what we do.

She was baptized, confirmed, and received her First Communion one Holy Saturday night. She was a true convert, joyfully brought into the Church she loved.

One day she said to me, "Catholics are so sophisticated. They know all about all the sacraments, and the saints, and all about the Mass. I never thought I was smart enough to be a Catholic. It's so intimidating."

Are we sophisticated? Intimidating? Of course not. But our rituals and traditions seem mysterious and remote to those joining us for the first time.

When you notice someone new in the pews, think about sitting next to them. Ask if they'd like some help following the Mass. Take a missalette and show them how to follow it.

Remember that Ethiopian eunuch who was reading the book of Isaiah when Philip asked him if he understood it. "How can I understand, if no one explains it to me?" (Acts 8)

Help a newcomer navigate the missalette. Explain those remote and mysterious parts of the Mass. I bet they'll join us next Easter, grateful for the gifts we often take for granted.

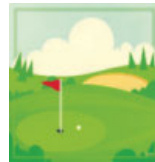

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## Decimoquinto Domingo de Tiempo Ordinario

“Porque este mandamiento que yo te ordeno hoy no es demasiado difícil para ti, ni está lejos.”

Cada vez que leo ese hermoso pasaje de Deuteronomio 30, recuerdo a mi amiga Becky, quien visitó la parroquia donde yo trabajaba hace muchos años e inmediatamente se enamoró de "todo lo católico".

Nunca había estado en una iglesia católica. Se quedaba largo rato viendo las estatuas de los santos. Cuando el Pan y el Vino fueron elevados, sintió que le faltaba el aliento.

Se convirtió en la estudiante más devota. Se sentaba con el misal por horas, haciéndonos preguntas de por qué hacemos esto u lo otro.

Se bautizó, se confirmó, y recibió su Primera Comunión un Sábado de Gloria por la noche. Fue una verdadera conversa, acogida con alegría en la Iglesia que amaba.

Un día me dijo: «Los católicos son tan sofisticados. Lo saben todo sobre los sacramentos, los santos y la misa. Nunca pensé que fuera lo suficientemente inteligente para ser católica. Es tan intimidante».

¿Somos sofisticados? ¿Intimidantes? Claro que no. Pero nuestros rituales y tradiciones parecen misteriosos y remotos para quienes se unen a nosotros por primera vez.

Cuando veas a alguien nuevo en las bancas, siéntate a su lado. Pregúntale si necesita ayuda para entender la misa. Toma un misal y enséñale cómo seguirlo.

Recuerda a aquel eunuco etíope que leía el libro de Isaías cuando Felipe le preguntó si lo entendía. "¿Cómo podré entenderlo si nadie me lo explica?" (Hechos 8).

Ayuda a un recién llegado a desenvolverse con el misal. Explícale esas partes remotas y misteriosas de la misa. Apuesto a que se unirá a nosotros la próxima Pascua, agradecido por los dones que a menudo damos por sentados.

Cuando hagas tu ofrenda o donativo, asegúrate de ponerlo en un sobre con tu nombre completo y domicilio.

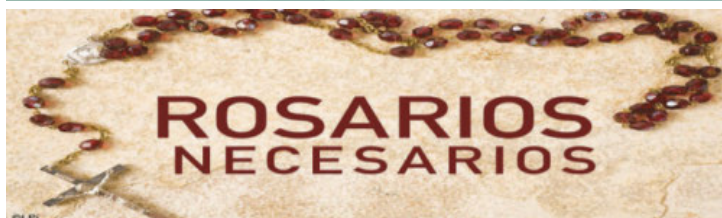

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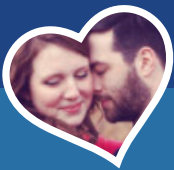
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
