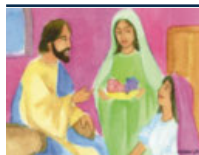

Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Our lives are full of mystery. How did our future spouses happen to be in the grocery store, the bookstore, or the same class we were taking, at the exact moment when we “bumped into them,” all those years ago? How did all those moments line up to put us in the right place at the right time? It’s a mystery.

Is our solar system unique? Until as recently as the 1990s, the answer would have been “no.” But today, we know that we are not alone. And then a million new mysteries confound. Is there “conscious” life outside planet Earth? That’s the question that informs every science fiction book and movie. Will some of those mysteries be solved in our lifetimes?

I think that Jesus was mysterious. His birth was announced by angels, and a STAR in the heavens. Two elderly prophets recognized him when his parents brought him to the Temple, and, twelve years later, teachers in the courtyard of that same Temple were amazed at his questions.

Years later, surrounded by the hungry and the sick, he promised that everyone who asks will receive, and everyone who seeks will find (Lk. 11:9-10). With what assurance? It’s a mystery. And then there was the time he encouraged his friend Mary to sit at his feet and learn, and nudged her sister Martha to leave her work to join him (Lk. 10:38-42). How did this first-century Orthodox Jew understand what would take another two thousand years to finally enter the culture?

But the greatest, and most indelible mystery? Christ in you, your hope of glory (Col. 1:27). He lives in you. He is in you every moment. Be at peace.

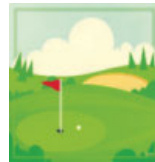

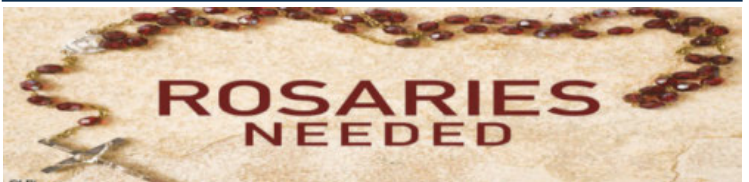

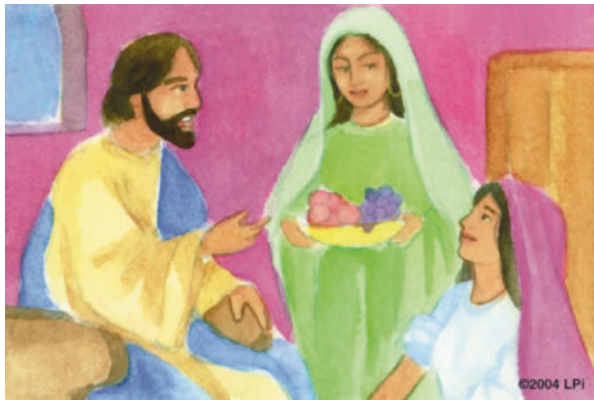

Decimo Sexto Domingo de Tiempo Ordinario

Nuestras vidas están llenas de misterio. ¿Cómo fue que nuestras futuras parejas estaban en el supermercado, la librería o en la misma clase que nosotros, en el preciso momento en que nos las encontramos hace tantos años? ¿Cómo se alinearon todos esos momentos para ponernos en el lugar correcto en el momento correcto? Es un misterio.

¿Es único nuestro sistema solar? Hasta hace tan poco como la década de 1990, la respuesta habría sido "no".

Pero hoy sabemos que no estamos solos. Y entonces un millón de nuevos misterios nos confunden. ¿Existe vida "consciente" fuera del planeta Tierra? Esa es la pregunta que inspira todos los libros y películas de ciencia ficción. ¿Se resolverán algunos de esos misterios durante nuestras vidas?

Creo que Jesús era misterioso. Su nacimiento fue anunciado por ángeles y una estrella en el cielo. Dos profetas ancianos lo reconocieron cuando sus padres lo llevaron al Templo, y, doce años después, los maestros en el patio de ese mismo Templo se maravillaron con sus preguntas.

Años después, rodeado de hambrientos y enfermos, prometió que todo el que pida recibirá, y todo el que busque encontrará (Lc. 11:9-10). ¿Con qué seguridad? Es un misterio. Y luego está la ocasión en que animó a su amiga María a sentarse a sus pies y aprender de él, y animó a su hermana Marta a dejar su trabajo para compartir con él (Lc. 10:38-42). ¿Cómo comprendió este judío ortodoxo del primer siglo lo que tardaría otros dos mil años en integrarse finalmente en la cultura?

Sin embargo, ¿Cuál es el misterio más imborrable? Cristo en ti, tu esperanza y tu gloria (Col. 1:27). El vive en ti. El está en ti en cada momento. Ten paz.

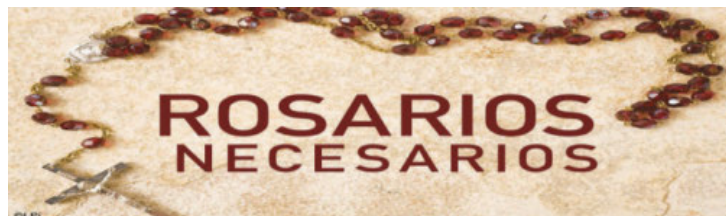
El Programa Rosa de Plata en Honor a la Vida y a Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe
