17th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Once I went to a hospice facility to celebrate Last Rites for an elderly dying man. His family had told me that he had been uncommunicative for days. At the conclusion of the ritual, we began to recite the

Our Father prayer. To everyone's surprise, his lips moved, clearly mouthing the words to the Lord's prayer. Stripped of most of his faculties, the man could still pray those precious God-given petitions. A lifetime of prayer had planted the words even deeper than his failing consciousness.

Do we want the Lord's prayer to be as deeply embedded in us? If we want to be people of hope, we should. Recall that our Lord immediately follows the prayer by saying: **"Ask, and it will be given to you; search, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened to you"** (Luke 11:9). We only ask, search and knock because we hope that the request is not in vain. Everything we could possibly hope for is contained in the prayer. Praying the Our Father deepens our hope.

We should consciously pour all our hopes into the Lord's prayer; we should allow it to be an expression of hope, not simply rote words. Then, over time, it builds up our hope in God. It sinks deep into our souls and bodies. How blessed we are when these words of hope are on our lips, even when everything else seems to fail.

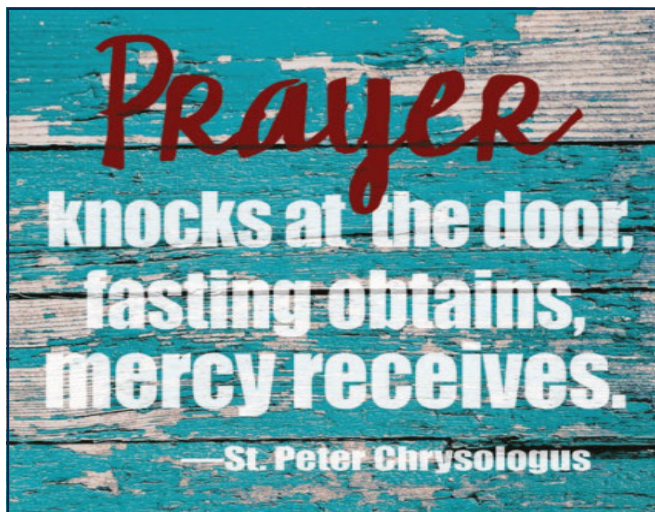

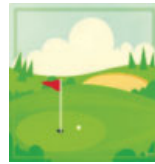
Women's Prayer Study

XVII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Es fácil mirar la lectura del Evangelio de hoy y salir con una visión de Dios desinteresado e irritado, reacio a darnos lo que necesitamos a menos que derribemos su puerta, lo persigamos hasta los confines más lejanos del cielo, lo arranquemos de su ensoñación y lo obliguemos a responder solo para que finalmente nos vayamos.

Bueno, eso no es lo que Jesús quiere decir con la parábola del amigo a medianoche, pero tampoco es sorprendente que pensemos que lo es. El punto de este Evangelio es que la comunicación entre Dios y el hombre se ha roto. No es tan fácil como antes, como debería ser, como podría ser.

En esta parábola, existen muchas barreras entre el suplicante y su amigo. La hora del día no es la ideal. La puerta está cerrada con llave. Sus disposiciones son opuestas: uno está en medio de un ciclo REM y el otro está profundamente agitado. Parecen ser dos personas que no están preparadas para comunicarse bien. Todo juega en su contra.

Lo mismo podría decirse de Dios y de la raza humana. Aquí estamos en un mundo caído, rodeados de pecado, dolor, enfermedad y muerte hasta el punto de que se infiltra no solo en nuestros cuerpos, sino también en nuestras almas, nuestras mentes, nuestras actitudes.

Somos el amigo sorprendido desprevenido en la oscuridad de la noche. No siempre sabemos cómo hablar con Dios (*¡Esa puerta es gruesa! ¿Nos escuchará si llamamos?*). No siempre sabemos si debemos (*después de todo, es culpa mía que me haya quedado sin panes*). Ni siquiera sabemos si queremos (*¡Es de noche! ¡Podría estar enojado!*).

Todo está en nuestra contra.

No importa, nos dice Jesús. Lo que sea que esté interrumpiendo la comunicación entre tu corazón y Aquel que lo creó, Aquel que desea su atención plena e irrevocable, puede ser superado. No hay puerta lo suficientemente gruesa, ni noche lo suficientemente oscura, ni sueño lo suficientemente fuerte.

Así que llama.

Cuando hagas tu ofrenda o donativo, asegúrate de ponerlo en un sobre con tu nombre completo y domicilio.

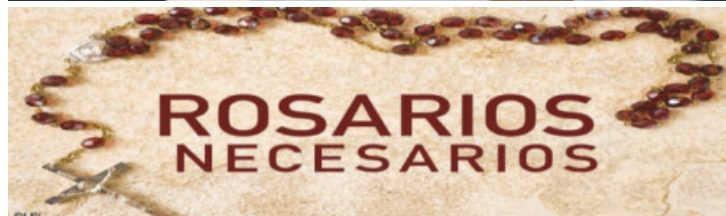
