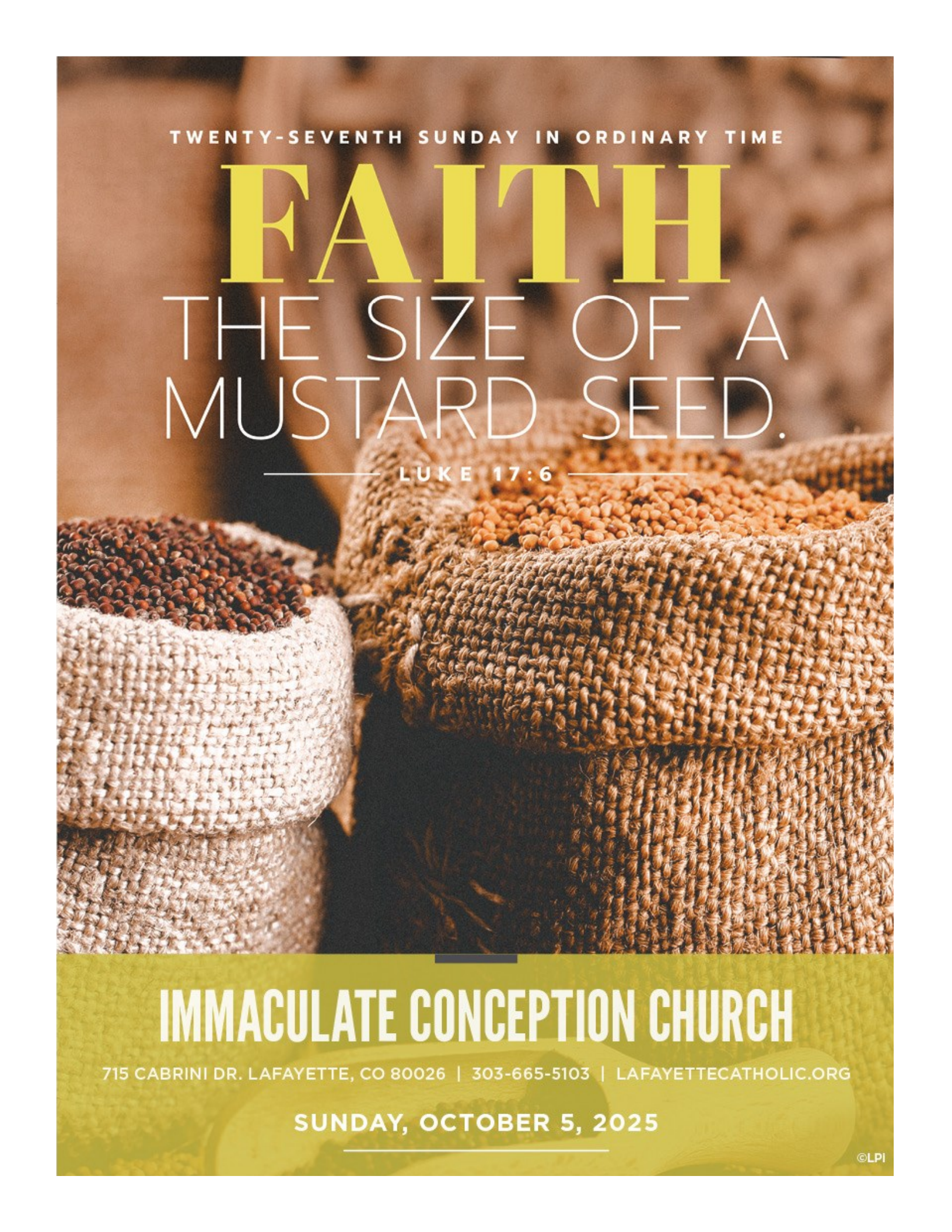

Twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

That Habakkuk reading today is too close to home. The prophet writes, “How long, O LORD? I cry for help, but you do not listen!”

I heard the cry of those brave Evergreen High School students who said, “My whole life, my whole childhood, was devoted to keeping me safe from a school shooter. And he came for us anyway.” And, of course, the horrific shooting during the first school Mass of the year at Annunciation grade school in Minneapolis is too terrible to recount, too tragic to remember.

How many of us, though, as we watched in horror, silently said to God, “I cry out to you, ‘Violence!’ but you do not intervene. Why do you let me see ruin; why must I look at misery?”

Habakkuk has a front row seat to the impending misery about to be visited upon Israel. He can see the Babylonian army marching towards Israel. He dreads the violence, the bloodshed, the loss of life that surely marches into Israel with King Nebuchadnezzar.

He demands that God give him an answer. WHY do you allow such violence, especially at the hands of evildoers? In fact, a third of the population died by the sword, a third by fire, and the last third was taken into exile. God tells Habakkuk to wait, that the vision written on the tablet will surely come. Seventy years later, long after Habakkuk’s death, the vision was realized. The captives came home.

But will it take seventy years for the vision of a nation where schools are havens of safety and learning to be realized? We can do better. That, I think, is what’s written on the tablet.

In what ways are you advocating for gun safety?

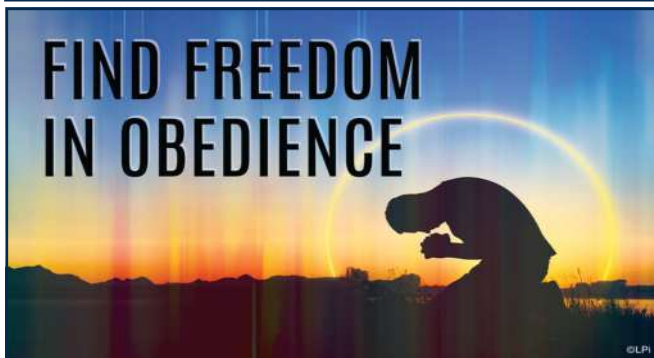

Vigésimo Séptimo Domingo de Tiempo Ordinario

Esa lectura de Habacuc de hoy me resulta demasiado cercana. El profeta escribe: “¿Hasta cuándo, Señor? ¡Clamo por ayuda, pero no me escuchas!”.

Escuché el clamor de aquellos valientes estudiantes de la preparatoria Evergreen que dijeron: “Toda mi vida, toda mi infancia, la dediqué a protegerme de un tirador escolar. Y aun así vino por nosotros”. Y, por supuesto, el horrible tiroteo durante la primera misa escolar del año en la escuela primaria Annunciation de Minneapolis es demasiado terrible para contarlo, demasiado trágico para recordarlo.

Sin embargo, ¿cuántos de nosotros, mientras observábamos con horror, le dijimos a Dios en silencio: “Te clamo: ¡Violencia!, pero no intervienes. ¿Por qué me dejas ver la ruina? ¿Por qué debo contemplar la miseria?”.

Habacuc presenció en primera fila la inminente miseria que se abatiría sobre Israel. Ve al ejército babilónico marchando hacia Israel. Teme la violencia, el derramamiento de sangre y la pérdida de vidas que sin duda invadirán Israel con el rey Nabucodonosor.

Exige que Dios le dé una respuesta. ¿POR QUÉ permites tanta violencia, especialmente a manos de malhechores? De hecho, un tercio de la población murió a espada, otro tercio a fuego y el último tercio fue llevado al exilio. Dios le dice a Habacuc que espere, que la visión escrita en la tabla sin duda se cumplirá. Setenta años después, mucho después de la muerte de Habacuc, la visión se hizo realidad. Los cautivos regresaron a casa.

Pero, ¿tardará setenta años en hacerse realidad la visión de una nación donde las escuelas sean refugios de seguridad y aprendizaje? Podemos hacerlo mejor. Eso, creo, es lo que está escrito en la tabla.

¿De qué maneras abogas por que las armas se usen de una manera más segura?

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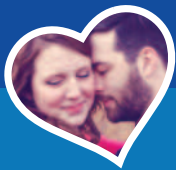
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
