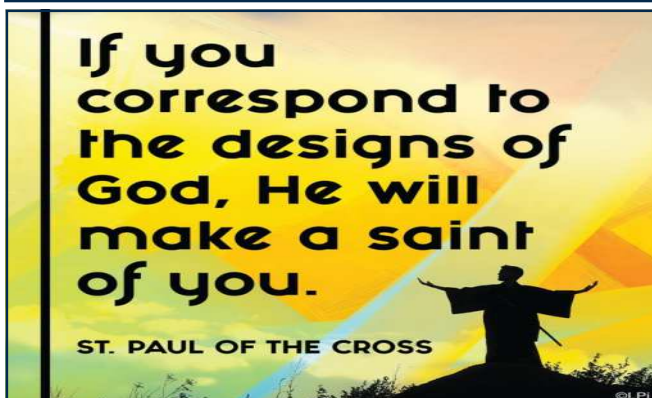

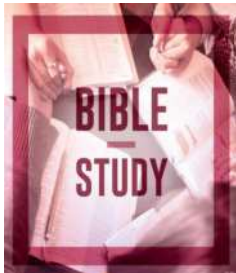

Vigésimo-Noveno Domingo de Tiempo Ordinario

Una de las grandes alegrías de tener amigos de toda la vida es que, si prestamos atención, nos sorprenden. Justo cuando creemos conocerlos a fondo, dicen o hacen algo que nos hace mirarlos con nuevos ojos.

Las parábolas son así. La viuda y el juez están en nuestro ADN. Conocemos al juez de corazón duro (e incluso puede que tengamos personas en nuestras vidas que nos lo recuerden), y, por supuesto, la viuda

da somos nosotros, rogándole a Dios cada día por las cosas que necesitamos y por la paz en la tierra.

Pero una canción, *The Widow and the Judge*, de Colleen Fullmer, (animada por la Hna. Martha Ann Kirk, CCVI, me impactó y me hizo ver de una manera nueva esta historia icónica, y nunca la he visto igual desde entonces. ¿Qué pasa si la viuda necesitada no somos nosotros, rogándole a Dios que nos dé lo que necesitamos, sino Dios? ¿Qué pasa si Dios es la viuda, llamando a las puertas de NUESTROS corazones, y nosotras somos el juez, reteniendo las cosas buenas necesarias para una verdadera paz en la tierra?

¿Y si no somos nosotros quienes buscamos justicia, sino Dios, quien nos ruega que la hagamos? Esto nos lleva a preguntarnos: si escuchamos a la viuda (Dios) llamando a la puerta, ¿cederemos finalmente y haremos justicia verdadera? Justicia, justicia buscarás, dice Deuteronomio 16:20. Y no domesticemos a esa viuda. Abraham Heschel escribe que «Dios se enfurece en las palabras de los profetas». Es imposible no escucharla.

Y esa última línea del evangelio de hoy realmente impacta. ¿Encontrará Dios fe en la tierra cuando Cristo regrese? Se rumora que hay una generación de jóvenes católicos reavivándose. Ojalá que así sea.

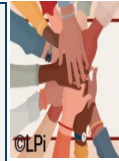

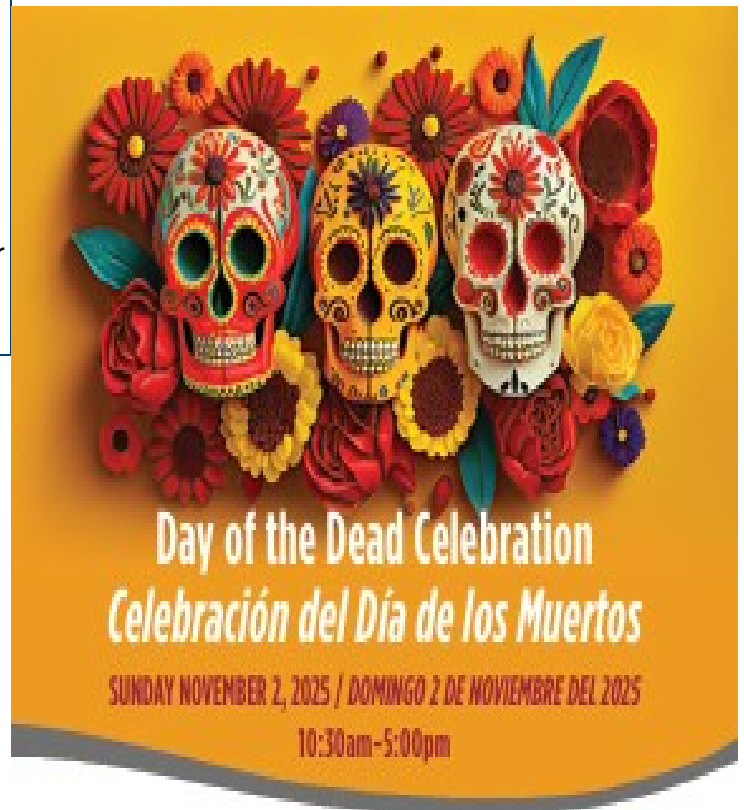
