The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed

Hope does not disappoint. I believe this with all my heart. And St. Paul believed it, even as he wrote to the many Christians in Rome who longed for his visit. Those same Christians may have suffered the same martyrdom as Paul, who had been a prisoner in Caesaria before being taken in chains to Rome.

From whence do those who suffer from painful illnesses, or devastating losses, summon the faith and joy to say with confidence that hope does not disappoint? Their witness to this most basic tenet of faith fills us with hope too, and then our witness strengthens those around us.

This is the scripture to take to the cemeteries today as we remember our beloved dead. As you drive around, take in all the love of those who buried their precious loves there. We assent to St. Paul's exhortation, and believe that all these believers found their hope realized, in ways they could never have imagined.

The souls of the just are in the hand of God, Imagine being held, carefully and lovingly, in the hand of God. And cast that vision over the cemetery, over all the graves, many of them hundreds of years old. Pray for each person there, and announce Paul's words: Hope does not disappoint.

We don't have to wait until death to experience hope satisfied. There is some tiny glimmer of hope for peace in the Middle East. There are the victories over headaches, bad colds, and even once fatal diseases. There are restored relationships that once seemed terminal. In each of these, we have reason to hope.

Hold fast to hope. It's your entrée into the heart of God.
In what area of your life do you need the grace to hope?

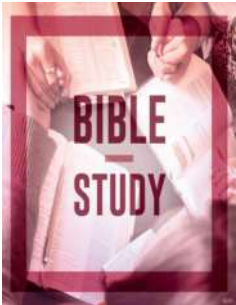

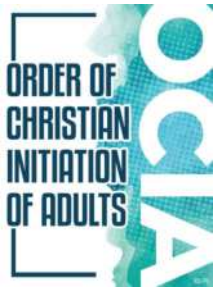

La Conmemoración de los Fieles Difuntos

La esperanza no defrauda. Lo creo de todo corazón. Y San Pablo lo creía, incluso al escribir a los numerosos cristianos de Roma que anhelaban su visita. Esos mismos cristianos podrían haber sufrido el mismo martirio que Pablo, quien había estado prisionero en Cesarea antes de ser llevado encadenado a Roma.

¿De dónde sacan la fe y la alegría para afirmar con confianza que la esperanza no decepciona aquellos quienes sufren enfermedades dolorosas o pérdidas devastadoras? Su testimonio de este principio fundamental de fe también nos llena de esperanza, y nuestro testimonio fortalece a quienes nos rodean.

Esta es la escritura que debemos llevar hoy a los cementerios al recordar a nuestros seres queridos fallecidos. Mientras paseas por el cementerio, absorbe el amor de quienes enterraron allí a sus seres queridos. Nos adherimos a la exhortación de San Pablo y creemos que todos estos creyentes encontraron su esperanza realizada, de maneras que jamás imaginaron. Las almas de los justos están en las manos de Dios. Imagina ser sostenido, cuidadosa y amorosamente, por la mano de Dios. Y proyecta esa visión sobre el cementerio, sobre todas las tumbas, muchas de ellas centenarias. Ora por cada persona allí y proclama las palabras de Pablo: La esperanza no defrauda.

No tenemos que esperar hasta la muerte para sentir la esperanza satisfecha. Hay un pequeño rayo de esperanza de paz en el Medio Oriente. Hay victorias sobre dolores de cabeza, resfriados fuertes e incluso enfermedades que alguna vez fueron mortales. Hay relaciones restauradas que alguna vez parecían terminadas. En cada una de estas, tenemos motivos para tener esperanza. Aférrate a la esperanza. Es tu puerta de entrada al corazón de Dios.
