The Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome

This is interesting. Last week, the Thirty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time was preempted by the beautiful Commemoration of All Souls. But this week, the Thirty-Second Sunday is preempted by a building? Ah, but it's not just any building. Since the fourth century, the Church has reserved November 9th—even if it falls on a Sunday near the end of Ordinary Time—for the Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome.

I always thought there must have been a saint named John Lateran. Wrong. There's a basilica built on the Lateran hill in Rome, named for Saint John. Taking some time to glance at today's readings helps to make sense of why this church is considered so sacred. The scriptures are overflowing — like the life-giving river that flows from the Temple to the sea in Ezekiel's vision today — with imagery of buildings. The Temple, in particular, is the most sacred of all buildings.

And yet, Jesus says that HE is the Temple. His listeners took him literally, of course, and didn't understand until after the Resurrection that when he said, "Destroy this Temple and in three days I will raise it up," he was talking about his own death and resurrection.

And here's the thing. It's not just Jesus who is the new Temple. St. Paul says, "The Temple of God, which you are, is holy." This is why the remembrance of the dedication of this basilica is so precious that we interrupt Ordinary Time to commemorate it. This basilica is the "mother Church," not just for the pope but for the whole world, and we are its living stones.

We are the foundation. Stand strong.

Fiesta de la Dedicación de la Basílica de San Juan de Letrán en Roma

Esto es interesante. La semana pasada, el trigésimo primer domingo del Tiempo Ordinario estuvo marcado por la hermosa Conmemoración de los Fieles Difuntos. Pero esta semana, ¿el trigésimo segundo domingo está marcado por un edificio? Ah, pero no se trata de un edificio cualquiera. Desde el siglo IV, la Iglesia ha reservado el 9 de noviembre —incluso si cae en domingo cerca del final del Tiempo Ordinario— para la Fiesta de la Dedicación de la Basílica de Le-

trán en Roma.

Siempre pensé que tal vez existió un santo llamado Juan de Letrán. Me equivoqué. Hay una basílica construida en la colina de Letrán, en Roma, que lleva el nombre de San Juan. Dedicar un momento a leer las lecturas de hoy ayuda a comprender por qué esta iglesia se considera tan sagrada. Las Escrituras están repletas —como el río que da vida y que fluye del Templo al mar en la visión de Ezequiel— de imágenes de edificios. El Templo, en particular, es el más sagrado de todos.

Y sin embargo, Jesús dice que ÉL es el Templo. Sus oyentes, por supuesto, lo interpretaron literalmente y no comprendieron hasta después de la Resurrección que, cuando dijo: «Destruiré este templo, y en tres días lo levantaré», se refería a su propia muerte y resurrección.

Y aquí está la clave: no solo Jesús es el nuevo Templo. San Pablo dice: «El templo de Dios, que sois vosotros, es santo». Por eso, el recuerdo de la dedicación de esta basílica es tanpreciado que interrumpimos el Tiempo Ordinario para conmemorarla. Esta basílica es la «Iglesia madre», no solo para el Papa, sino para el mundo entero, y nosotros somos sus piedras vivas.

Somos la base. Permanezcamos fuertes.

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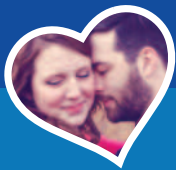
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
