Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

I don't generally think of John the Baptist as a dreamer, or a stargazer. But today he admits to seeing a vision: *I saw the Spirit come down like a dove from heaven and remain upon him.*

Why do these biblical figures have visions and dreams, and we don't? My great Denver friend Fr. Pat Dolan thinks that modern humans have "evolved" away from the deep gifts of intuition and "seeing" that was common to the ancients. Two thousand years ago, the great Baptizer met Jesus, reluctantly complied with his wish to be baptized, and then actually saw the Spirit descend upon him.

But here's the thing: I think we, too, often see the Spirit descend. Think of your favorite homilist. Don't you "see" the Spirit descend when he digs deep into the scriptures and gives you something rich and beautiful upon which to meditate?

Watch your friends with their grandchildren. Years and years of parenting seem to have given them a sixth sense about how to listen to these dear ones, how to truly "see" them, and how to navigate their temporary whining and bring them back to that gentle place of delight and content that makes being with them such a joy.

Or think of the musicians you know. Watch them sit down at the piano and take mastery of it. Can you see the Spirit descend? Think of any person you love, really. Aren't there many times a day when you "see" the Spirit descend as they bring kindness into the world?

Make this the year when you pay closer attention to the Spirit's "descent." Chances are, the Spirit hovers over you all the time.

What person in your life seems to have the Spirit's presence always?

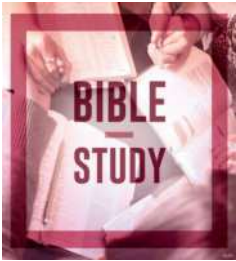

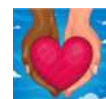

Segundo Domingo de Tiempo Ordinario



Generalmente no considero que Juan el Bautista fuese un soñador, o un observador de las estrellas. Pero hoy él admite que tuvo una visión: *vi al Espíritu descender como una paloma y postrarse sobre él.*

¿Por qué estas figuras bíblicas tenían visiones y sueños, y nosotros no? Mi gran amigo de Denver, el padre Pat Dolan, cree que los seres humanos modernos nos hemos alejado, a través de la evolución, de los profundos dones de la intuición y la clarividencia que eran comu-

nes entre los ancestros. Hace dos mil años, el gran Bautista conoció a Jesús, accedió a regañadientes a bautizarlo y luego vio cómo el Espíritu descendía sobre él.

Pero aquí está la cuestión: creo que nosotros también vemos con frecuencia como desciende el Espíritu. Piensen en su predicador favorito. ¿Acaso no perciben la presencia del Espíritu cuando profundiza en las Escrituras y les ofrece algo valioso y hermoso en que meditar?

Observen a sus amigos con sus nietos. Años y años de crianza parecen haberles dado un sexto sentido para escuchar a estos pequeños, para comprenderlos de verdad y para manejar sus rabietas pasajeras y devolverles esa dulce sensación de alegría y serenidad que hace que estar con ellos sea un deleite.

O piensen en los músicos que conocen. Obsérvenlos sentarse al piano y dominarlo con maestría. ¿Pueden ver descender al Espíritu? Piensen en cualquier persona a la que quieran de verdad. ¿Acaso no hay muchos momentos al día en que "ven" descender al Espíritu cuando esa persona irradia bondad en el mundo?

Que este sea el año en que presten más atención a la "descensión" del Espíritu. Lo más probable es que el Espíritu los acompañe constantemente.

¿Qué persona en tu vida parece tener siempre la presencia del Espíritu?

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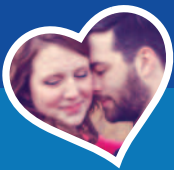
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
