Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

And so it begins. Jesus learns that John has
been arrested (Matthew 4:12-23) and is being
held in Herod's terrifying, lonely dungeon. The
back story of his arrest isn't given to us by

Matthew for another ten chapters (14:1-13).

It's then that he tells the whole ghastly story of John's arrest by
Herod Antipas, and his beheading at the behest of Herod's ille-
gally wedded wife, Herodias.

But this is all to come. When today's gospel opens, we only
know that John has been put in prison. This event marks the
end of John's ministry, and the beginning of Jesus' public life.
One senses the strong foreboding Jesus must have felt. His
forerunner is gone, and now he must fulfill the words of his
baptism: "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well
pleased."

At first, he retreats to Galilee, perhaps realizing he may have
no other time to be with his Mother. When he leaves Nazareth,
it's crucial to note that he travels north, straight to the lands of
Zebulun and Naphtali. These were called the "Galilee of the
Gentiles" because, eight centuries earlier, the violent nation of
Assyria had invaded those lands, dragged the Jews away, and
repopulated the land with Gentiles.

Jesus is the fulfillment of Isaiah's prophecy about those lands:
"On those dwelling in a land overshadowed by death, a light
has arisen" (9:1-2). It's to these "half-breed" people, forgotten
Gentiles living in Jewish territories, that Jesus' first words of
hope and consolation are preached.

Imagine living there, and seeing Jesus before anyone else.
Wherever we are, Jesus will go and find us.

What would you say to Jesus if he came to find you?

Tercer Domingo de Tiempo Ordinario

Y así comienza. Jesús se entera de que Juan ha sido arrestado (Mateo 4:12-23) y se encuentra retenido en el aterrador y solitario calabozo de Herodes. Mateo no nos revela la historia de su arresto hasta diez capítulos después (14:1-13).

Es entonces cuando narra la espantosa historia del arresto de Juan por Herodes Antipas y su decapitación por petición de Herodías, su esposa ilegítima.

Pero todo esto está por venir. Al comienzo del evangelio de hoy, solo sabemos que Juan ha sido encarcelado. Este acontecimiento marca el final del ministerio de Juan y el comienzo de la vida pública de Jesús. Podemos percibir el fuerte presentimiento que Jesús debió haber sentido. Su precursor se ha ido, y ahora debe cumplir las palabras de su bautismo: «Este es mi Hijo amado, en quien me complace».

Al principio, se retira a Galilea, quizá consciente de que no tendrá otro momento para estar con su Madre. Al salir de Nazaret, es crucial destacar que viaja al norte, directo a las tierras de Zabulón y Neftalí. Estas tierras eran llamadas la «Galilea de los gentiles» porque, ocho siglos antes, la violenta nación de Asiria las había invadido, expulsando a los judíos y repoblando la tierra con gentiles.

Jesús es el cumplimiento de la profecía de Isaías sobre esas tierras: «El pueblo que andaba en tinieblas vio gran luz; los que moraban en tierra de sombra de muerte, luz resplandeció sobre ellos.» (9:1-2). Es a estos mestizos, gentiles olvidados que viven en territorios judíos, a quienes Jesús predica sus primeras palabras de esperanza y consuelo.

Imagina vivir allí y ver a Jesús antes que nadie. Dondequiera que estemos, Jesús nos encontrará.

¿Qué le dirías a Jesús si viniera a buscarte?

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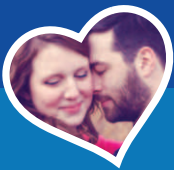
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
