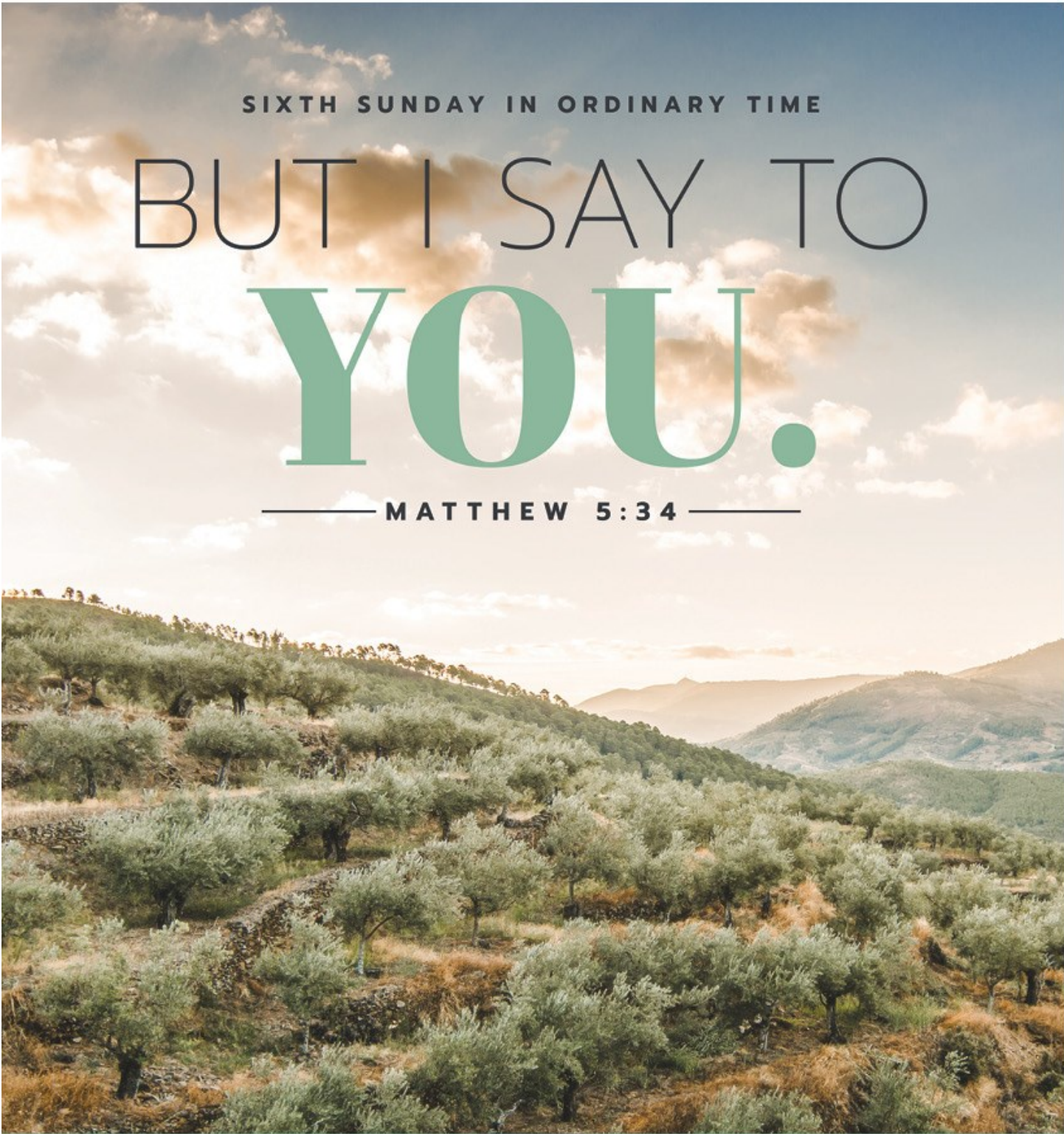

Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Therapists and marriage counselors all agree on the number one behavior of engaged couples who aren't going to make it: contempt. The rolled eyes, the crossed arms, the incredulous stare—these are all signs that at least one of the partners holds spoken (or maybe unspoken) contempt for the other. That's a huge red flag, and a warning that there are many serious issues that need to be brought to light before this couple attempts to marry. Sure, we all know the Ten Commandments, especially “Thou shalt not kill,” but dig deep into the reasons for this command, and we find unspoken anger, violent language, and quiet contempt for the other. It's usually considered bad form to bring this contempt into the light by actually saying out loud the ugliness we harbor in our hearts towards the people we secretly despise, but unless we truly repent of this contempt, it will eventually find its way out of our hearts and into malicious gossip, simmering rage, and, in the worst cases, physical violence. This portion of the Sermon on the Mount thwarts our attempts to compromise our faith. If your right hand is your trouble, gouge it out and throw it away. Yikes. Who among us hasn't broken promises, harbored resentments, imagined the vengeance we would take if given the opportunity? I think this hyperbole that Jesus uses, to gouge out our eyes rather than be thrown into Gehenna, is a good example of the reasonable way to approach a challenging text like this. Everyone has temptations. Has anyone ever actually gouged out their eyes? The greatest danger is to bask in our contempt. Pray that another isn't doing the same towards you.

Fasting consists of eating only one meal, with the possibility of two smaller snacks that do not add up to a single full meal.

Catholics age 14 and older are to abstain from meat on all Fridays in Lent.

Sexto Domingo de Tiempo Ordinario

Los terapeutas y consejeros matrimoniales coinciden en que el principal comportamiento de las parejas comprometidas que no van a perdurar es el menosprecio o desdén. Cosas como los ojos en blanco, los brazos cruzados, la mirada incrédula: todas estas son señales de que al menos uno de los miembros de la pareja siente menosprecio, ya sea explícito o no, por el otro. Esto es

una gran señal de alerta y una advertencia de que hay muchos problemas graves que deben resolverse antes de que esta pareja intente casarse.

Claro, todos conocemos los Diez Mandamientos, especialmente "No matarás", pero si profundizamos en las razones de este mandamiento, encontramos ira escondida, lenguaje violento y un desprecio silencioso hacia el prójimo. Generalmente se considera de mala educación sacar a la luz este menosprecio expresando abiertamente la fealdad que albergamos en nuestro corazón hacia quienes despreciamos en secreto. Sin embargo, a menos que nos arrepintamos sinceramente de este menosprecio, con el tiempo irá saliendo a través de chismes maliciosos, ira latente y, en el peor de los casos, violencia física.

Esta parte del Sermón del Monte frustra nuestros intentos de comprometer nuestra fe. Si tu mano derecha te causa problemas, sácatela y tírala. ¡Caramba! ¿Quién de nosotros no ha roto promesas, albergado resentimientos, imaginado la venganza que tomaríamos si se nos diera la oportunidad? Creo que esta hipérbole que usa Jesús, de sacarnos los ojos en lugar de ser arrojados al infierno, es un buen ejemplo de la manera razonable de abordar un texto tan desafiante. Todos tenemos tentaciones. ¿Alguien se ha sacado los ojos alguna vez?

El mayor peligro es mantenerse cómodamente sintiendo ese menosprecio. Reza para que nadie sienta eso por ti.
